If you find a dog in the meantime, please let us know so that we can update our records. Your name will be removed from our list after 6 months. Please contact us again if you wish to remain on our list after this time.

Changes in the EU laws on the protection of personal data require us to establish the following, and we ask you to sign below if you are happy for us to retain your data as described.

We (Southern Cavalier Welfare) will retain this information as long as required for that purpose.
